#### ATTENTION ALL SUNDAY SCHOOL KIDS!!

Effective as of Sunday February 2nd, we have changed our Sunday School format! Kids will arrive at 8:45 and go to the Lower Level of the Church. Parents may then proceed to the Sanctuary where our regular Worship Service will begin at 9:00, as always. The acolyte will join the service when the congregation receives the sign of Peace. The remaining children will rejoin the service as they will come upstairs to ring the bell for the Lord's Prayer, participate in Communion and the blessing, and be dismissed with their families. We are hoping that this will be a great way for kids to receive instruction about the Bible and our loving Lord, Worship in "Kid-Style" fellowship; build their faith, and meet the needs of their families as well.
